 - (L.D. 1426) AN ACT TO SECURE HOUSING FOR THE MOST VULNERABLE MAINE RESIDENTS BY AMENDING THE LAWS GOVERNING MUNICIPAL GENERAL ASSISTANCE (PRESENTED BY REPRESENTATIVE MATHIESON, K. OF KITTERY)
 - (L.D. 1664) AN ACT TO INCREASE REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THE GENERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EMERGENCY) (PRESENTED BY SENATOR MOORE, M. OF WASHINGTON) - BEST BILL
 - (L.D. 1732) AN ACT TO EXPAND THE GENERAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EMERGENCY) (PRESENTED BY REPRESENTATIVE MEYER, M. OF ELIOT)
- ADVOCATE WITH CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION FOR WORK AUTHORIZATION CHANGES
